Ensure that the heating wire section on the blankets is clear of the pillow and does not hang over the sides of the mattress. Pull the elastic inside the fitted skirt over the ends of the mattress. Ensure to pull the middle of the blanket so that it is evenly stretched and distributed over the entire mattress, ensuring there are no creases or rucking. **NOTE** The heated blanket must not be wider than the mattress with which it is to be used. It is normal for a small section of the fitted skirt to be showing on top of a larger sized mattress. No heating wire must be trapped or tucked into any part of the bed. The heating wire should not hang over the sides of the mattress. Ensure the elastic of the

blanket skirt is completely under the entire mattress and secure. When fitted to the mattress correctly, the controller sockets should be positioned at the top end of the mattress, near occupants shoulder area. NOTE Ensure that the blankets is stretched completely flat when placed on the mattress and creases or rucking is not evident. To connect your controller, insert the controller plug into the controller socket on the heated blanket. Ensure that the plug is securely fastened in the socket so that the locking clips are fully inserted and no gap between the plug and socket, as per picture below. NOTE The controller plug is designed to only fit the socket correctly one way if the plug does not push in fully, turn the plug around. Push the locking clips on the controller plug together to release and withdraw the plug from the controller socket. 12 14 STORING YOUR CONTROL UNIT Remove the controllers when laundering your blanket. Store your controllers during summer months while your blanket remains on the bed as a comfortable under blanket. OPERATING YOUR HEATED BLANKET Your BodyZone by Breville heated blanket has dual zone heating technology that allows you to choose from 6 heat settings for your upper and lower body and an autooff timer which allows you to preprogram the blanket to turn off after a set number of hours up to 9hrs. Press the HEAT button; the upper body of the icon will start flashing, indicating that the temperature is being adjusted for this zone of the heated blanket NOTE On initial use, it is recommended that the blanket be set on highest setting 6,6 for 3 hours before sleeping on the bed. This will assist in drying out any moisture which has been accumulated in the mattress. Once the heat setting is confirmed the blanket will start heating. SETTING THE AUTOOFF TIMER BodyZone heated blankets have a programmable autooff feature. This timer can be programmed from 1 to 9 hours to automatically turn the heated blanket off. This is displayed on the right hand side of the LCD screen. NOTE The autooff function, either programmed or after 9 hours, will only turn the blanket off no heat. The controller will remain in standby until manually switched to the OFF position. Press the TIMER button; the number of hours will then flash. To program the auto setting, slide the control switch up from OFF to AUTO, then follow the previous instructions for using the controller on the MANUAL setting. The heated blanket can then be switched off at the controller. When next used, slide the control switch up from OFF to AUTO. The LCD screen will illuminate and

HAND WASHING Immerse the heated blanket with controllers removed in a soapy solution of lukewarm water and mild, neutral detergent. Soak for five minutes then gently squeeze the solution through the blanket. Rinse thoroughly in clean, lukewarm water, then gently squeeze any excess water from the heated blanket. MACHINE WASHING The heated blanket can be washed in a domestic washing machine size permitting or by a commercial laundry. When washing in a domestic washing machine, wash on the WOOL or DELICATES setting using a neutral detergent or mild soapy solution. DO NOT wash on a HOT cycle; the temperature must be kept below 30 C. DO NOT use high speed or extra spin cycles. DO NOT machine wash with the controllers connected to the blanket. AIR DRYING Drape the heated blanket across a clothes line and drip dry. DO NOT use pegs to secure the heated blanket in position DO NOT Dry with a hair dryer or heater. DO NOT twist or wring dry. And even then, not all are up to Australian and New Zealand electric blanket safety standards. To be sure that the ones we reviewed were up to scratch, we first checked CHOICE, Australias top consumer advocate. We then crosschecked against Consumer NZ, which is the Kiwi counterpart of CHOICE. There were a number of blankets that stood out, so we did some research comparing electric blankets features.

There were a multitude of hot options, from intuitive temperature technology, all the way to antibacterial blankets. Comparing these products involved checking supplier websites to confirm safety features, warranties and add-ons. From here, we narrowed the list down to around 14. One particular brand dominated the list. We don't write paid reviews, and we try not to read them either, so we checked Canstar Blue, another Australian consumer comparison site. This confirmed the brands reputation in the electric blanket category. After lopping the lowest rated blankets from the list, we headed to ProductReview.com.au to find out what consumers had to say. What we discovered was that electric blanket reviews were skewed. While some customers loved electric blankets with timers, others hated this function, giving their blankets a bad review. Given that they

can overheat, we tended slightly towards reviews that valued electric blanket safety features. To narrow down our selection, we cut any products that rated less than 3.5 stars out of 5. Finally, it was time to choose a winner. The winning blankets were chosen because we felt that their prices fairly reflected their features, and because consumer electric blanket reviews closely matched what the experts said. That left us with 9 blankets, including 4 overall winners. Check price The Sunbeam SleepPerfect stands out from the rest. It has the most electric blanket safety features, and is competitively priced. Of course, almost all reliable electric blankets have safety features and addons, but few tick all the boxes. The SleepPerfect electric blanket, on the other hand, goes from strength to strength with little compromise. One of its most impressive features is its clever heating technology, which adjusts the power to maintain your desired heat setting.

This electric blanket is designed to sense and adjust with your body temperature for optimal warmth, which makes it an ideal choice for those who like their blanket on all night. The constant temperature monitoring prevents the blanket from overheating, as it reduces the power supply if the blanket heat is above the desired setting.
