## Betamethasone Dipropionate 0.05% and 0.12% cream

### What is this medicine?

BETAMETHASONE is a corticosteroid. It is used on the skin to treat swelling, redness, itching, and allergic reactions.

# What should my health care professional know before I take this medicine?

They need to know if you have any of these conditions:

- acne or rosacea
- · any type of active infection
- diabetes
- · glaucoma or cataracts
- · large areas of burned or damaged skin
- skin wasting or thinning
- an unusual or allergic reaction to betamethasone, corticosteroids, other medicines, foods, dyes, or preservatives
- · pregnant or trying to get pregnant
- breast-feeding

### How should I take this medicine?

This medicine is for external use only. Do not take by mouth. Wash your hands before and after use. Apply a thin film of medicine to the affected area. Do not cover with a bandage or dressing unless your doctor or health care professional tells you to. Do not use on healthy skin or over large areas of skin. Do not get this medicine in your eyes. If you do, rinse out with plenty of cool tap water. It is important not to use more medicine
