Only if you're taking a BMV-approved driver's education course. A copy of your Certificate of Enrollment in Driver Education is required. I failed my knowledge exam, what can I do? Collapse all I am 15 years of age and I hold an IN learner's permit. Can I practice driving? A BMV-approved driver education program is the only way to get this exemption. A minimum of 50 hours of driving instruction with the following organizations are required: I am between 16 and 18 years of age and I hold an IN learner's permit. Can I practice driving? A minimum of 50 hours of behind the wheel training must be completed with: I am 18 years old or older and I hold an IN learner's permit. Can I practice driving? A licensed relative of at least 25 years old must sit next you in the automobile for at least 50 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction (including 10 hours at night). How long is my Indiana learner's permit valid? Two (2) years. Where can I take my driving skills exam? at a BMV location or driving school, where you finished your driver's education. Do I have to schedule an appointment for my driving skills exam? Yes. Visit myBMV.com or the BMV Contact Center. Do I have to provide a vehicle for the driving skills exam in Indiana? Yes, you have to provide one. I successfully completed my Indiana BMV driver education program. Do I have to take the driving skills exam? If you have a waiver for the skills test, no. Can a relative or a friend ride in the car with me during the driving skills exam? No. No one besides you and the examiner is allowed in the car during the exam. When can I retake my driving skills exam in Indiana if I fail? At the very least, 14 days are required. I passed my driving test, can I obtain my IN driver's license? Yes. To get a learner's permit while under the age of 21, you must be at least 21 years of age and 30 days of age at the time of application. Do I have any restrictions when driving with my Indiana probationary driver's license? The first 180 days after your license issuance are known as the "grace period." When you are at least 15 years of age, you may take a written knowledge test to get your permit in Indiana. The written exam consists of 50 multiple-choice questions in two sections. You must answer a minimum of 28 of the 34 rules questions correctly, and at least 14 of the 16 road sign based questions, to pass. Questions are based on the 2025 Indiana Driver's Manual and will cover topics from traffic laws and safe driving techniques, to road signage and traffic signals. Drivers of all ages, unless they've previously held a driver's license in another state, must receive their learner's permit and complete a minimum 50 hours of driving, including 10 hours at night under supervision, before they may qualify for a driver's license. If you're between 15 and 16 years of age and want to receive your learner's permit, you'll need to be enrolled in a driver's education course. If you do not want to take a driver's education class, you'll be required to wait until you're 16 before you may take your knowledge exam and apply for a permit.
