The location provides affordable watercraft rentals. Many options are available, from canoes to jet skis. The lagoon has different areas for traffic, and non-motor kayaks and canoes use the eastern shore to access a larger area. Jet skis have their own section, while ski boats use an additional area. There are small beaches where you can stretch your legs or enjoy a picnic. The main customer area is modest with a rental office, refurbished restrooms, boat launch, store, and picnic area. Food and drinks are available for purchase. There is free parking nearby. California Watersports is a great place to enjoy the Carlsbad Lagoon with various activities such as paddle boarding and wakeboarding. The employees are young and friendly, welcoming customers to their water's edge. However, some customers have reported feeling pressured into booking for longer periods or being charged for unused rentals. Many people have expressed interest in visiting the Carlsbad Lagoon Marina, but some have been unsure about its policies or availability. The marina has a long history of welcoming visitors from all over, including families with children, who often enjoy activities like paddleboarding and kayaking. In fact, the lagoon is surrounded by three other waterways - Agua Hedionda, Batiquitos, and Buena Vista - making it an excellent destination for those interested in water sports. One reviewer praised the marina's staff, saying they were "unbelievably kind, helpful, and accommodating," a testament to their high standards. The reviewer even went so far as to say that this experience was "amazing" and that they would return again and again. On the other hand, some visitors have raised questions about specific policies, such as whether dogs are allowed or if there are age restrictions for certain activities.
